

Bataan is implementing a provincial-wide K-12 Pilot Study with all the member schools of BAFTI or Bataan Federation of Technical Institutes through a GRANT provided by SFI Group and its international partner ACT of America.



What is the GRANT?

The GRANT given by SFI Group and ACT to the Bataan Province is composed of the WorkKeys Assessments, the KeyTrain Curriculum and Learning Management System which complement the Department of Education's K-12 Initiative for curriculum compliance. It is the intent of all the stakeholders in this project to implement and run a "Pilot Study" with the majority of the educational institutions located in Bataan.

The Purpose of the Pilot Study:

In trying to help the government and the Department of Education with the right implementation and transition from K-10 to the K-12 system, SFI Group and ACT want to validate the successful use of "career readiness skills" through ACT's KeyTrain Curriculum. We also want to prove that incorporating these Career Ready Skills in the education of Grades 11 and 12 would not only address the K-12 Compliance issue, it also addresses the issue of Workforce Development.
